## J. Andrew McKee Fellowship Program

The application process is now open for the joint The Stem Cell Network and JDRF Canada's [J. Andrew McKee Fellowship Program in Type 1 Diabetes](#). Running for the second year, the objective of the J. Andrew McKee Fellowship Program is to attract relatively early career researchers working in stem cell and regenerative medicine research with a focus on Type 1 Diabetes to join the [JDRF Centre of Excellence](#) at the University of British Columbia.

### Applicant Eligibility

MD, DMD, DVM, PhD, or equivalent received at least two months prior to the commencement of the fellowship. Must not be simultaneously serving an internship or residency. Individuals who already hold a position as a student, fellow or staff member in a lab affiliated with the Centre of Excellence at UBC are NOT eligible to apply.

### Application Process

1. Please send a brief email with subject heading: "The J. The body of the email should indicate your intent to apply for the program. Please attach your CV to the email.
2. All interested applicants must access and submit full applications to [Stem Cell Network](#) via [ProposalCentral](#) by **February 28, 2023, at 17:00 ET**.

### Award

This award is valued at \$60,000 per year, of which \$57,500 is stipend and \$2,500 is research allowance.

Please note that this award is 1 year in duration. However, the supervisors at the Centre of Excellence have committed an additional 2 years of funding support for each recruited Fellow, as such, the successful candidate should anticipate their time at the Centre to be at least 3 years in length.
